



 Course Description: This internship is a supervised work experience in a position within the industry of the student's Career and Technical

 Education program of study. This internship provides on the job experience and valuable industry networking. Students must provide their own transportation to their worksite. CO/PREREQUISITE: Advanced/Intermediate Course within Student's Program of Study

 GRADE: 12 (minimum 16 years of age)
 LENGTH: Year
 DVUSD High School CREDIT: 1.0

Course Objectives: Individual objectives will be developed based on student placement and program of study. These objectives will be documented in the student's trt 20.627D77bi7477bi7

Students will be evaluated in cooperation with employers/supervisors/mentors.

- Weekly Activity/Hour Reports & Verification (minimum of five hours per week)

Reflections (6 per semester)

Scheduling and Completion of Quarterly Evaluation Visits
