So that I am able to provide your child with a severe allergy the best care possible, I am asking you to assist me in the prevention, care and management of your child's severe allergies and reactions. Of

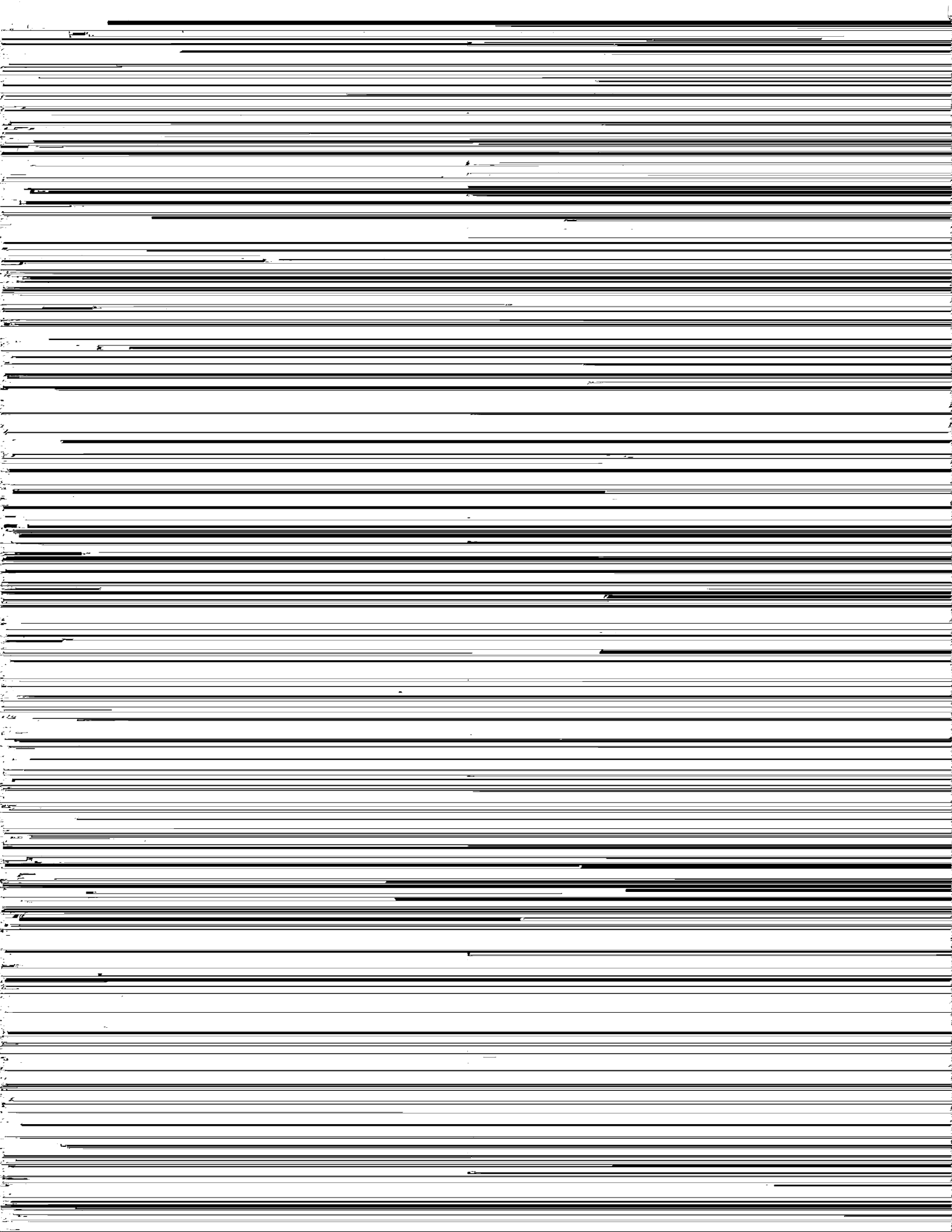

We have provided a peanut/nut/allergen free table in the cafeteria. The

of this table is to keep your allergic child physically separated from peanuts/nut containing products, as well as any other allergen identified, while in the cafeteria. The table is clearly marked peanut/nut/allergen-free and we have separate cleaning solutions for that table used before and after eating. Because of the dangers of cross contamination, we cannot safely oversee lunches brought from home by other students. Therefore, to maintain the table as peanut/nut/allergen free, only those children who have purchased lunch in the cafeteria may be guests at this table. Your child may talk with Nurse Jamie BEFORE LUNCH if s/he has a friend with a lunch from home and it can be checked for allergens. The lunchroom monitor will enforce this immediately. Your child also plays a crucial role in his/her safety by staying seated at the table provided and by alerting the monitor if he/she begins to experience any signs or symptoms of an allergic reaction. We ask that you review this policy with your child and send the bottom portion back to the health office (along with the child's Severe Allergy Health History and Anaphylaxis Emergency Action Plan) by Friday, August 10th
